WHAT HAPPENS TO YOUR DONATED CLOTHES?

95% of the textiles we collect are re-used.

In October 2014 an agreement was made with DAPP UK in which a payment is made to Planet Aid UK for the service of collecting and sorting the clothes from the charity's own clothing banks on their behalf. This arrangement comprises approximately 20% of Planet Aid UK's overall collection. Any 'shop-quality' items are then sent to DAPP UK's charity shops in Northampton, Rugby, Corby and Leicester.

75% of the textiles collected are sold, unsorted, to our existing customer base in Eastern Europe, with any lowquality reusable textiles and single shoes being sold to our customers in Pakistan.
